

LEARNING SUPPORT POLICY

The School has Learning Support Department to help those with dyslexia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia, and other specific learning needs. Additionally a part-time teacher of English as an Additional Language is available to help those for whom English is not their first language. (See also the SEN and Learning Difficulties Policy.)

Learning support in all subjects is available to all boys during the Pursuits Periods when each department will be staffed to provide whatever help might be required. Additionally all new boys receive a copy of the School's Study Skills brochure on joining the school, and those in the first three years are given a Prep Diary each term. Each of these documents gives advice on the quality and preparation of work.

The School is developing a programme of Extension and Enrichment Activities and, where possible, these are also open to pupils from other schools.

There are currently no pupils with a formal statement of educational need. We would consider the support required for any possible future candidate on a case by case basis.
