# COWDREY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2023

Colin Cowdrey (Lord Cowdrey of Tonbridge), 1932-2000, was one of the great sportsmen of the 20th century. In memory of this distinguished Tonbridgian, and to promote and recognise the qualities that he embodied, we have established the Cowdrey Scholarships.

Three or more Scholarships will be offered for award each year, for entry to the school at age 13, to boys of character and integrity who display both sporting excellence and sportsmanship in at least one of the main school team games: rugby, cricket, hockey and football.

The awards will be determined by recommendation and assessment.

Candidates must be proposed and recommended by the Head of their current school (i.e. parents cannot make independent application), by printing and completing the application form at the end of this document. This form may be accompanied by a more detailed letter of recommendation from the Head of their current school and/or testimonials from others.

Assessments will be held at Tonbridge at the same time as the assessments or auditions for all other categories of non-academic scholarship awards (Music, Art, Design, Technology and Engineering, Drama).

For the 2023 awards these assessments and interviews will be held the week beginning 23 January. Candidates will be asked to

come to Tonbridge for a day and will take part in both individual and team sports, as well as fitness and leadership events organised by sports staff. There will also be a short interview with senior staff members.

#### **Remission Amount**

Cowdrey scholars will be awarded a prize of £2,000, which will be deducted from the first term's fees. The award of a scholarship may additionally provide fee remission of any amount up to the full school fee, if assessment of the parents' means indicates a need.

#### **Age Limit**

Candidates for Cowdrey Awards must be under 14.0 on 1 September 2023.

#### **Multiple Awards**

A Cowdrey Scholarship may be held in conjunction with any other scholarship awards at Tonbridge.

#### **Key Dates**

- The application form of an intending candidate must reach the Admissions Office by 1 December 2022.
- Examinations will take place in the week beginning 23 January.
