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JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title	Volunteer Gallery Steward – Old Big School
Reporting to	Gallery Administrator
Main Purpose	To supervise artworks and monitor public visitors, both internal and external during the exhibition's run.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To steward for 1-2 sessions per week (a session is 4 hours) during the exhibition's run.
- Assist in keeping the artwork safe by monitoring the gallery.
- Turn on and off any TV monitors/MP3 players/electrical devices being exhibited if relevant.
- Report and suspicious incidents to Security.
- Record the number of visitors and provide basic information to the public and visiting schools.
- Undertake any other duty as required by the Gallery Administrator.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The successful candidate must maintain the confidentiality of information regarding the School, its staff and its business. Information must not be communicated to other persons either in or outside the School except in the recognised course of their duties.

CHILD PROTECTION

The post-holder's responsibility for promoting and safeguarding the welfare of children and young persons for who he or she is responsible, or with whom he or she comes into contact will be to adhere to and always ensure compliance with the School's Safeguarding and Child Protections Policy. If in the course of carrying out the duties of the post the post-holder becomes aware of any actual or potential risks to the safety or welfare of children in the School he or she must report their concerns to the Designated Safeguarding Lead or to the Headmaster.

This post would ideally suit someone who communicates well with others, has an interest in Art and is able to commit to a minimum of 4 hours per week.

HOURS OF WORK

4 to 8 hours per week during an exhibition's run.

VOLUNTEER GALLERY STEWARDS WILL BE:

- Provided with an induction tour of the Gallery, where the procedures for invigilating will be explained
- Given a Curator Tour at the start of each exhibition, to give a deeper insight into the works
- Invited to the opening of the exhibition and lectures relating to OBS Gallery
- Reimbursed for travel expenses upon production of receipts, at the end of the exhibition run
- Lunch in the Lowry Dining Room whilst invigilating.
